

Banner Display Diagram

We want to make it easy for you to display Children's Ministry banners.

So, here's a simple, portable, and affordable frame you can build for displaying banners up to 6 feet long. The frame is built with pvc pipes and can be taken apart and carried from event to event.

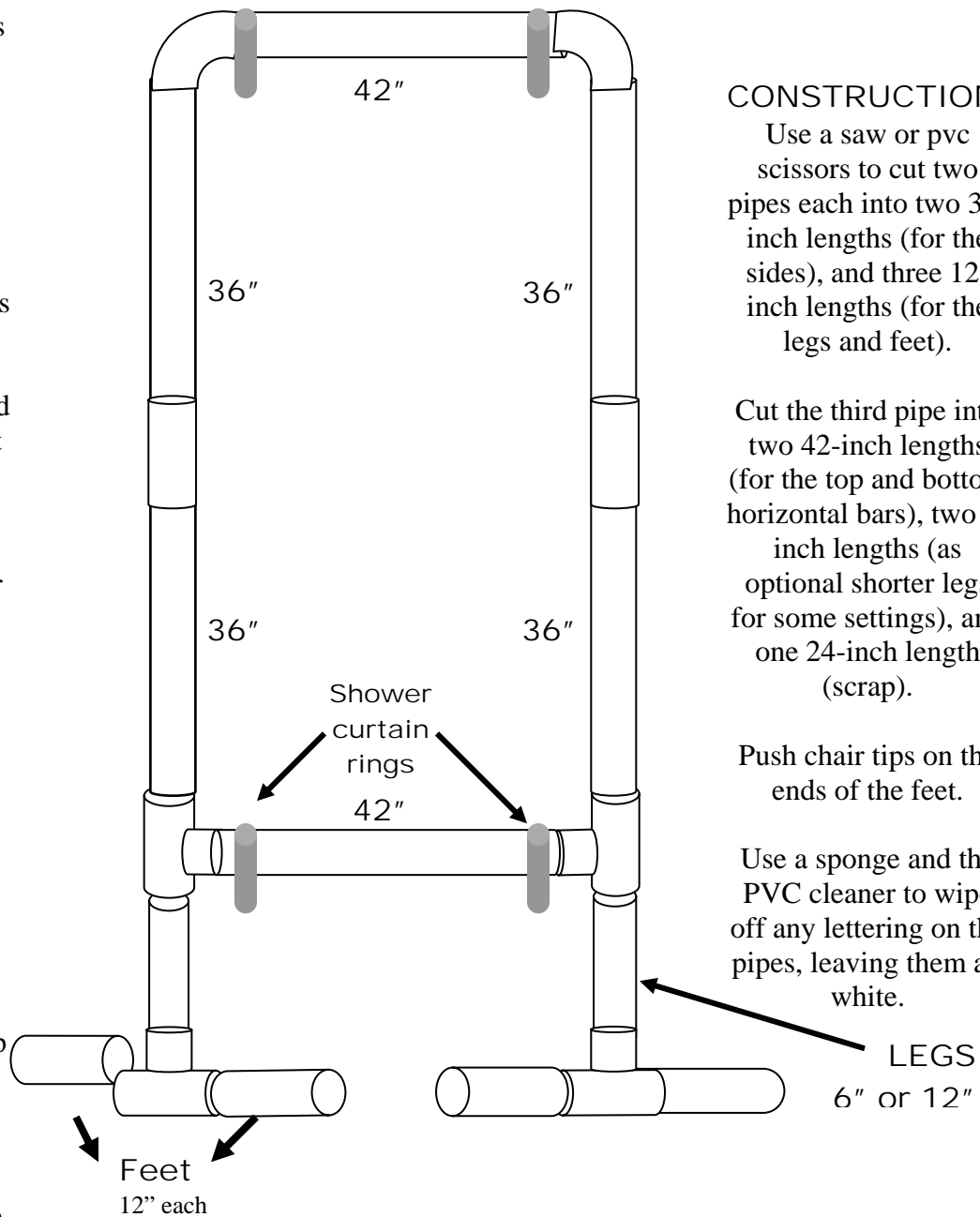
COST: \$5.00 for materials

ASSEMBLY:
Assemble the frame as shown.

Rotate the legs to be perpendicular to the frame.

To attach the banner to the top & bottom horizontal bars, slip shower curtain rings along pipe to go through grommets.

To hold banner taut, either fasten rings in place with strapping tape or partially insert screws into top and bottom pipes.



CONSTRUCTION:

Use a saw or pvc scissors to cut two pipes each into two 36-inch lengths (for the sides), and three 12-inch lengths (for the legs and feet).

Cut the third pipe into two 42-inch lengths (for the top and bottom horizontal bars), two 6-inch lengths (as optional shorter legs for some settings), and one 24-inch length (scrap).

Push chair tips on the ends of the feet.

Use a sponge and the PVC cleaner to wipe off any lettering on the pipes, leaving them all white.

LEGS
6" or 12"

Materials: (1/2" diameter)

4 'T' connectors

2 'L' / elbow connectors

2 straight connectors

3 10-foot pipes

4 7/8-inch chair tips

1 set of round metal shower curtain rings

PVC Clear Cleaner

Strapping tape or 4 screws
